

Water Fill Station Proposal

Town staff are proposing a new location for the water fill station. Due to the housing project and several other constraints, the previous location in the Northeast right of way of Henson street at the corner of 8th Street is less than ideal. The newly proposed site is just south of the intersection of Henson and 7th Street, on the west side of Henson along the school soccer field (see attached photos below).

If we move forward with this location, there will be some cost increases related to necessary underground infrastructure including electrical service and water line installation. These changes are expected to bring the total installation cost to around \$41,000, which is slightly above the budgeted amount.

We believe this location is more suitable, as it provides greater distance from the housing project, the medical center, Highway 149, and overhead power lines. We are suggesting installing all infrastructure including the water line, electrical, and concrete pad this year, then having the project completed before summer of 2027 due to 2025 budget constraints.

Estimated Project Costs

Water infrastructure - \$18,108.25

Electric Service Install - \$12,500

GCEA meter ect. - \$2,500

Concrete - \$1,000 - \$2,000

Building materials - \$6,000

Total - \$41,108.25
