Ski Hill – Nothing to report

Armory –

I purchased a mirror for the armory apartment bathroom and a couple throw rugs to protect the carpet

The basketball backboards and new poles were installed in July with the help of public works. We cleaned up the area back behind the armory.

Ice Rink - Nothing to report

Ice Wall - I started cutting and dragging the plastic piping out that will cover the insulation in places that we can't bury it. The sun fries the insulation on the main line and after about three years it is broken down completely.

Parks – I built a bench out of the two 8x8 beams that were purchased for the playground entrance and then it was decided not to use them for that purpose.

I roto tilled the entire gravel infield at Memorial Park to get rid of the weeds and then sprayed Ortho on the entire area to try to keep them from coming back. Public Works fixed the sprinklers and the park looks better than it has for a long time.

We hosted a soccer camp at Memorial Park in mid July.

Noxious Weeds -

The company from Montrose came over and sprayed all around Pete's Lake for thistle using a spray that they said was formulated for thistle. Steve Priest says it looks like its working.

Trees – The Arbor Day tree was planted on Aug 1st at the back of the town park. We also planted three more trees back along the town park alley. I'm trying to beautify that area.

Public works removed a large cottonwood that had started to fall over in front of Grant Houston's house on Bluff St.

Most of our time this time of the year is spent just maintaining parks and overseeing the normal recreation schedule.
