Ski Hill – The lift inspector was here on November 12th for the pre start up inspection. We needed a bigger fire extinguisher in the lift operator shack and he also wants us to do some sort of maintenance log for the platter hangers that we've never had to do before. Danny and Don have been prepping for the upcoming season. The platters are hung and they replaced the oil in the motor. They also changed a shiv wheel and adjusted the tension wire. Danny still needs to do the yearly ski inspections.

Armory

The sprinkler installers have been working on the armory office and apartment two days before Thanksgiving and they are back again this week. As soon as they are done, we can have the carpet installed upstairs. The floors are so uneven that it needs to be carpet with soundproofing. Willy is still planning on finishing the kitchen countertops and a few other small things.

Ice Rink – We have yet to put up the ice rink boards and flood the rink. We are so busy trying to get the ice wall up and running, there hasn't been any time. Weather hasn't been cold enough until now anyway.

Ice Wall – Several sections of ice wall have been running for a few weeks now. During the warm days we were losing the ice as fast as we made it at night. Things are better now. We are lacking an electrician which we contacted back in June. We can't run any of the new Sherwin Groceries section due to lack of electricity and now we have to abandon the new roly poly section to hook up pumphouse and Devils Kitchen due to an electrical short in a heat tape line which froze the pump. Things should get better eventually.
