RESOLUTION NO. 2026-11**

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE ONE TIME EVENT OF DOG DAYS OF
SUMMER TO BE HELD IN THE TOWN PARK**

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees of the Town of Lake City, Colorado (the “Board”), pursuant to Colorado statute, is vested with the authority of administering the affairs of the Town of Lake City, Colorado (the “Town”); and

WHEREAS, the Hinsdale County Chamber of Commerce (the “Chamber”) requested the Board consider a one-time exception of the prohibition against dogs in the Town Park contained in Section 4-23(e) of the Lake City Municipal Code (the “Code”) to host the Dog Days of Summer Event on September 5th, 2026 (the “Event”); and

WHEREAS, the Board recognizes Chamber proposes hosting the Event for the benefit of the Town and businesses within the Town; and

WHEREAS, the Chamber agrees to pay all applicable fees, deposits, and costs for the Event as well as ensure the park is reasonably returned to its pre-Event state and free from trash and dog waste to the reasonable satisfaction of the Town Manager; and

WHEREAS, approval of the Event by the Board does not create a precedent of permitting dogs in the Town Park and is intended to only permit a one-time variance to the prohibition of dogs in the Town Park pursuant to these unique set of facts and circumstances.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES
OF THE TOWN OF LAKE CITY, COLORADO AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Board hereby approves a one-time variance from the prohibition against dogs in the Town Park to permit the Chamber to conduct the Event pursuant to the conditions set forth above.
2. The Board designates, authorizes, and directs the Town Manager to authorize and inspect all aspects of the Event, including clean up, and take all actions necessary to ensure the provisions of this Resolution are fulfilled.
3. Severability. If any article, section, paragraph, sentence, clause, or phrase of this Resolution is held to be unconstitutional or invalid for any reason such decision shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of the remaining portions of this Resolution. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that it would have passed this resolution and each part or parts thereof irrespective of the fact that any one part or parts be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

4. Repeal. Existing resolutions or parts of resolutions covering the same matters embraced in this Resolution are hereby repealed and all resolutions or parts of resolutions inconsistent with the provisions of this Resolution are hereby repealed.
