In the spirit of community collaboration, the Town of Lake City is organizing two Community Junk Cleanup weekends this summer to assist the Town of Lake City residential property owners dispose of metal junk, free of charge.

Code Enforcement of Article II - Litter and Junk - Collaboration Over Citation

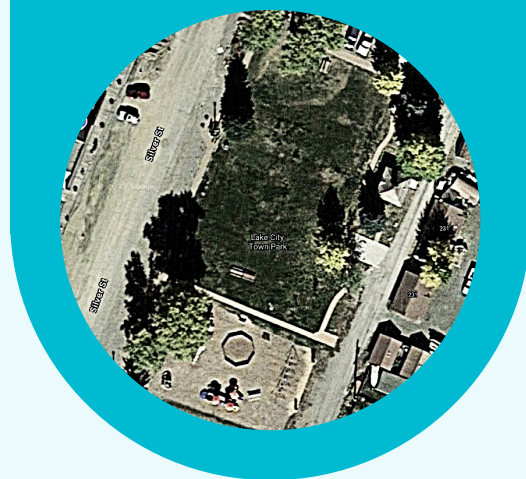
This coincides with the implementation of code enforcement action upon properties that are in violation of Article II – Litter and Junk, of the Lake City Municipal Code. Initial notices of violation will be mailed out late April/early May. These notices of violation have an initial deadline of 30 days for corrective action to be taken by the property owner, however, upon request the deadline can be extended up to a maximum of 180 days. This should give residential property owners plenty of time to take corrective action and participate in the Community Junk Cleanup weekends. If you do not receive a notice this year, we strongly encourage you to take advantage of the Town-Wide Community Junk Cleanup weekends as these may not be provided next year.

Free Disposal of Junk Containing Metal

To assist bringing Town of Lake City residents into compliance with regulations in Sec. 8-21 "Keeping of Junk" of the Lake City Municipal Code, the Town will be providing a 30-yard roll off from Recla Metals the weekends of June 13th – 14th and August 29th- 30th, for the free disposal of the following:

- Appliances: refrigerators/freezers (Freon must be removed), ovens, washers, dryers, grills, hot water heaters etc.
- Scrap Metal (Copper, Aluminum, Brass, Steel, etc.)
- Batteries
- Electronic Waste: Microwaves, CD/DVD players, PC's, Printers, etc. – No Monitors or Televisions
- Snow Mobiles, ATV's, OHV's, dirt bikes, motorcycles etc. (oil, gas, and coolant must be drained prior to disposal)
- Motors, engines, rotors, brakes, metal vehicle parts, etc.
- Lawn mowers, snow blowers, weed eaters, etc.
- Metal T-Posts, metal fencing, metal roofing, metal posts
- Metal siding, corrugated metal and construction materials
- Metal chairs, metal shelving, metal scaffolding, metal furniture etc.
- Electrical wires, coaxial cables

Hazardous Chemicals Must Be Removed Prior to Disposal

All oil, gasoline, and coolant must be removed prior to being dropped off.

All refrigerants must be removed prior to disposal.

County Commissioner Greg Levine, a certified refrigerant technician, has volunteered to remove refrigerants, free of charge, from all applicable appliances.

Please contact him directly to request the removal of refrigerants prior to the Community Junk Cleanup weekend events.

Town-Wide Community Cleanup Assistance Program and Application

The Assistance Program is intended to support Town residents who may need assistance with removing metal junk from their property. Priority will be given to seniors, individuals with mobility or health limitations, and those unable to remove metal junk too large to move on their own. We will NOT ask for financial statements or proof of income. Your honest self-assessment will help direct volunteer assistance to those who need it most. Location: Empty Lots North of the Medical Center

On the Community Junk Cleanup dates, the town-owned lots north of the medical center will be used as a staging area where metal junk can be dropped off, separated, and processed before being loaded into the Recla Metals roll off.

Please follow the instructions on posted signage as well as any verbal directions given by the attendant present. You will need to provide the address of your residential property that exists within Town boundaries to the attendant prior to dumping your junk.
