ACCEPTED ITEMS

- **Appliances:** refrigerators/freezers (Freon removed), ovens, washers, dryers, grills, hot water heaters
- **Scrap metal:** copper, aluminum, brass, steel
- **Batteries**
- **Electronic waste:** microwaves, CD/DVD players, PCs, printers (no monitors or televisions)
- **Snowmobiles, ATVs, OHVs, dirt bikes, motorcycles** (oil, gas, and coolant must be drained)
- **Motors, engines, rotors, brakes, metal vehicle parts**
- **Lawn mowers, snow blowers, weed eaters**
- **Metal fencing, roofing, posts, siding, corrugated metal, construction materials**
- **Metal chairs, shelving, scaffolding, furniture**
- **Electrical wires and coaxial cables**



IMPORTANT BEFORE DROP-OFF



All refrigerants must be removed before disposal.
