Ski Hill – Nothing to report

Armory –

I ordered a set of indoor bows and padded arrows for the kids to play archery tag in the armory. It's something else for them to do in the winter when they are trapped inside.

Ice Rink - Nothing to report except that I'm about to order a new rink liner for the upcoming season.

Ice Wall - Prepping the ice wall for the season will be an ongoing process until the water is turned on around Halloween. I'm currently trying to track down a short in the heat tape on Dynamite Shack. It happened at the end of the season last year and rather than finding it in the snow we decided just to shut the system down for the season. We are going to try to build a few more temporary log bridges this year to get the climbers across the river. I will go cut 18' logs in the forest but need to purchase a couple woodcutter permits from the forest service.

Parks – KC Wuest's last day for the season as summer help was on August 24th. Danny and I will have to do the daily bathroom and trash checks and continue to water the hanging baskets until the wine and music festival.

I did a little more landscaping in Town Park around the playground. I'm still wanting to plant a few more trees and get Town Park finished. They still need to finish the new playground sign archway.

Noxious Weeds -

The thistle at Pete's Lake is definitely dead. There is a little bit that they missed but it will take years of them spraying to kill it all.

Trees – We may trim some trees before fall as time allows. We don't have any more tree budget until Jan 1 for the professionals to do any work.
